## PERSONAL MATERIAL

### CHILDREN MUST BRING TO THE KINDERGARTEN

- The marking can be created thorough embroidery or by using a fabric marker.
- It's not necessary to apply the white square of fabric, but the mark has to be visbile

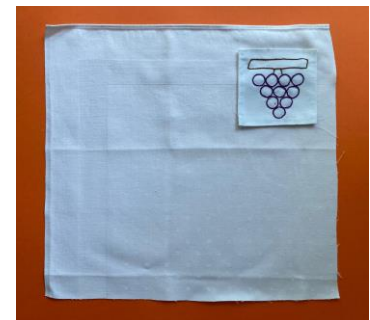
#### A FABRIC APRON

- with buttons on the front and a ribbon sewn on the neck for hanging
- with mark



#### CLOTH NAPKIN

- with mark



#### FABRIC BAG

- with two fabric ribbons and a size of approximately 40 x 40 cm
- with mark



## LITTLE TOWEL

- measuring 40 x 60 cm and a ribbon to hang it
- with mark



## A PAIR OF CLOSED SLIPPERS (not open slippers)

- with mark (marker)
- a pair of gym slippers



## LITTLE PILLOW (possibly with pillowcase)

- for a little nap, washable and marked



## A TOOTHBRUSH AND A TUBE OF TOOTHPASTE

- the toothbrush will be replaced as needed, in accordance with the teacher's instructions.
- with mark (permanent marker)



## SPARE CLOTHES (optional)

- we recommend leaving a change of clothes at the kindergarten in a plastic bag (underpants, socks, trousers, possibly a t-shirt and sweatshirt)
- with mark and/or name on the plastic bag



**During their time at the kindergarten, the child's personal belongings will stay at the facility.** Anything taken home in the cloth bag on Friday should be brought back to the kindergarten the following Monday, washed and in good condition.
